

EXCELLENCE OF FRENCH SAVOIR-FAIRE ADDS TO THE MAGIC

Immersion in this royal, unique, and sumptuous universe was made possible thanks to the work of the Disneyland Paris and Walt Disney Imagineering Paris teams, combined with the excellence of French companies renowned for their expertise and know-how in a wide range of arts and crafts, including tapestry, carpentry, weaving, glassmaking, porcelain and champagne. More than 200 French and European companies took part in the two-year reimagining.





The meticulously crafted, personalized experiences that awaits Disneyland[®] Hotel guests are made possible by the invaluable Cast Members of Disneyland Paris for which 27,777 costume pieces are currently being created, some of them including incredible work by **Dutel**, a Lyon-based company that specializes in making jacquard fabric for 85 years.

The Maison Pierre Mignon, a 5-generations family champagne producer based close to Epernay (France), has been carefully chosen to produce the exclusive Disneyland Hotel Cuvée. Following a long





The delicate tableware of the *Castle Club Lounge* has been specially created by **Maison Haviland**, a manufacturer specialized in Limoges porcelain founded in 1842, that combines modernism and creativity. The finishing touches and artistic decoration are carried out by hand by highly skilled craftsmen.

Just outside the *Fleur de Lys Bar*, guests will marvel at the central rotunda. Providing access to all hotel wings and restaurants, this elegant lounge area is adorned with blue décor accentuated by fleur-de-lys stitching, a dramatic cathedral ceiling, as well as mirrored walls and a central banquette shaped as a royal crown, both designed by with the collaboration of **CEMAD**, a French family-owned business specializing in fittings and joinery since 1877, who have also contributed to the design of many of the hotel's features, such as the libraries and the welcome desk of the lobby and the *Royal Kids Club*.





In the Signature Suites, Imagineers have worked with **Atelier Bournillat** to create unique design elements directly inspired from Disney royal classics. Disneyland Paris and Walt Disney Imagineering Paris have a long-standing relationship with this local workshop specialized in decor creations which also worked on the Beauty and the Beast statue at La Table de Lumière restaurant.

At the Royal Banquet, Disney's royal families take center stage in a gallery of unique portraits specially created for the Disneyland Hotel. Some take on an even more authentic form, like the family of Merida, from the Disney Pixar film Brave. To represent the DunBroch clan, Imagineers and artists at Pixar Studios drew direct inspiration from the film, set in medieval Scotland, to create a tapestry with a unique design. To bring their vision to life, Imagineers called on the expertise of the craftsmen at Tissage des Flandres. Located in the heart of the historic textile basin of Northern France, this workshop has been creating, weaving and making top-of-the-range tapestries for over 130 years.

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
